Choose ONE of the following for your Proof of English:

- A letter from a University Student Service or a qualified English instructor certifying your English ability. A letter must be:
 - on official letterhead from the academic institution
 - Signed and stamped by your English instructor or university teacher
 - Typed in English
 - Confirmation that your English ability level is at least intermediate, which is defined by: "Speaks in full sentences with minimal pauses and some complex sentence structure. Extensive vocabulary."
- Official results of a standardized English assessment
 - TOIEC (valid for 2 years)
 - TOEFL (valid for 2 years)
 - IETLS (valid for 2 years)
 - Cambridge Proficiency Exam (valid for 5 years)
 - Pearson Test of English General (valid for 2 years)
 - Pearson Test of English Academic (valid for 2 years)
- A confirmation letter from your exchange experience or university abroad, discussing your English ability level.
